MAYOR'S COMMENTS

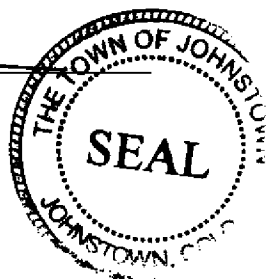
Mayor Duncan: He thanked everyone for their hard work. He also thanked Council for taking on roles within community groups in Johnstown.
